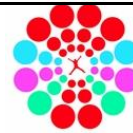

Since its inception, REDed has remained committed to nurturing creativity and promoting the physical and mental wellbeing of its students through dance; school-based programs are currently offered in Sydney and Brisbane.



About the roles

Our REDed dance Instructors teach curriculum-aligned, as well as extra-curricular programs in schools and staff are booked for short term or long term contracts before, during and/or after school. AGC Tutors and Tutor Trainees teach vibrant repertoire in extra-curricular classes during school terms and there is also the opportunity for occasional weekend work for big rehearsals and concerts.

Successful applicants will have:

- Experience (a little or a lot) in music, dance and/or performing arts education
It's desirable but not necessary to have specific choir experience or dance teacher experience. You might have an instrumental background, solo singing experience or be an aerobics teacher or gymnast.
- Experience teaching groups of children between the ages of 5 - 11
- A qualification in education and/or your chosen art form or be working towards such a qualification (desirable)
- A passion for education and the drive to champion the value of Performing Arts participation
- Well-developed communication and interpersonal skills
- Enjoyment of working with children
- A valid Working with Children's Check
